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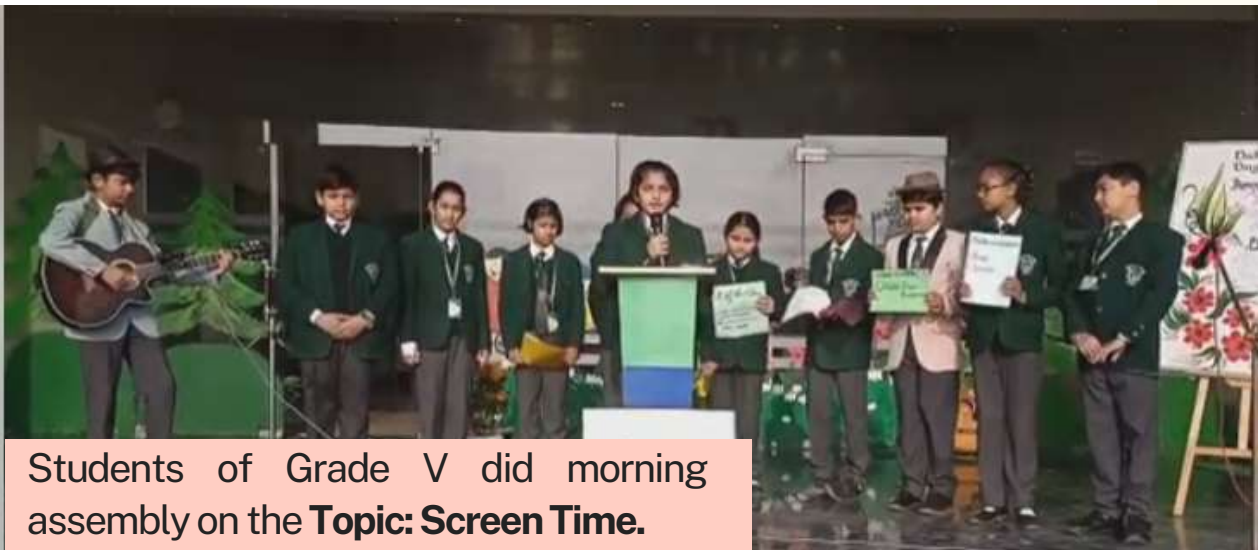




# Assemblies

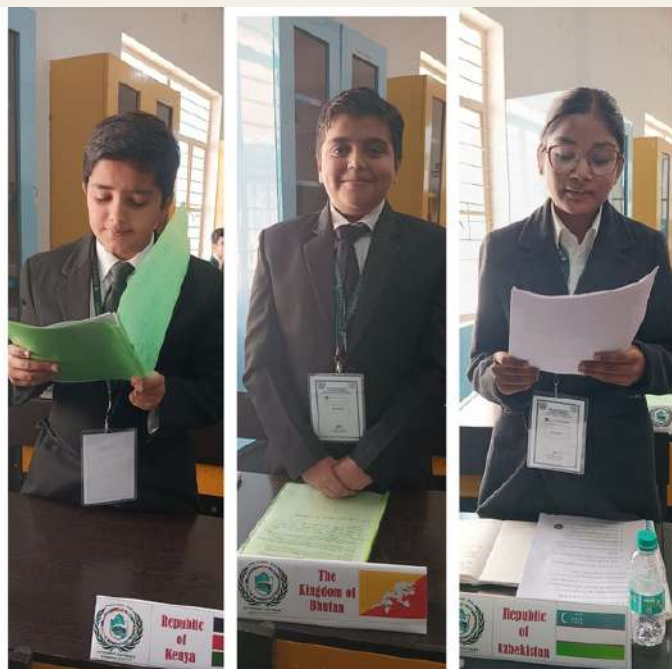




# Model United Nations

Grade IV students made a solution of water and sugar & water and salt. They understood about solute and solvent.



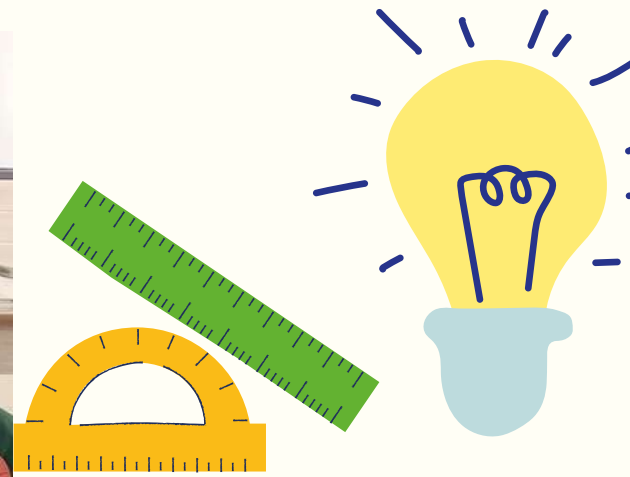

Students of class Nursery learnt 'AB' pattern in Montessori class. The ability to recognise and create patterns help the students to make predictions based on their observations.



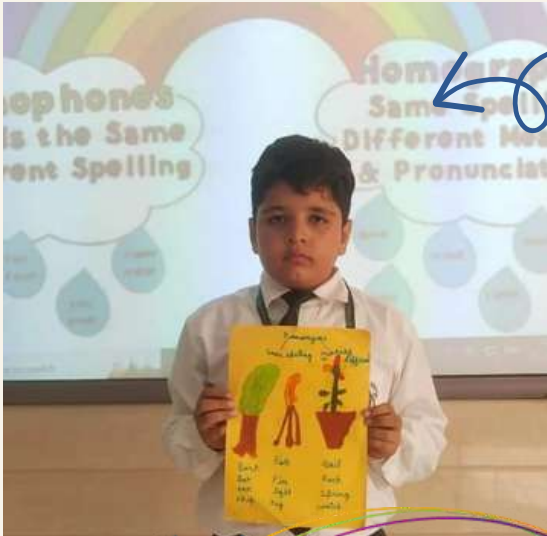
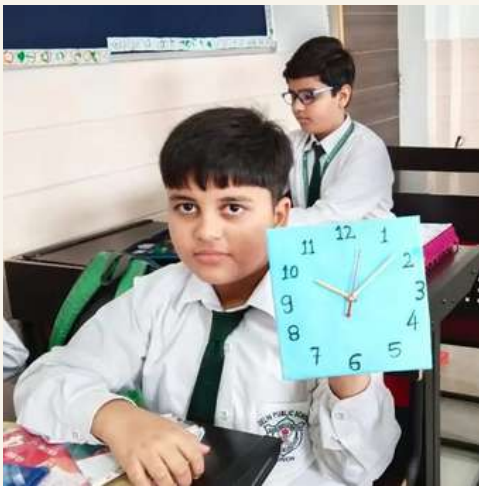
### READING NEWSPAPER ACTIVITY

A Role play is one of the creative ways of learning. Considering this, the students of Grade-V performed different roles of freedom fighters and learnt about the sacrifices made by them.



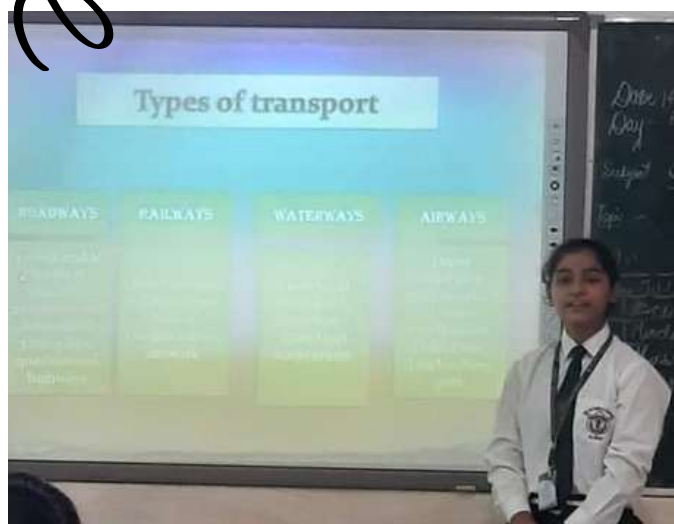
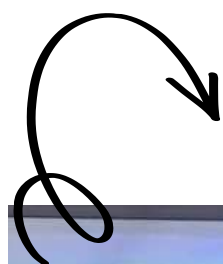

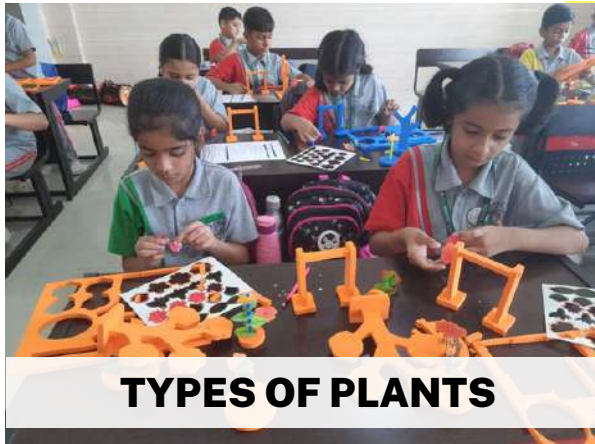

The students donated various things like clothes and other items of daily use to the head of the Ashram .





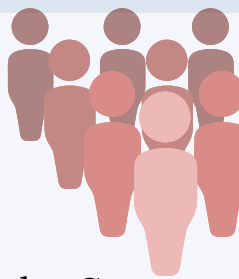

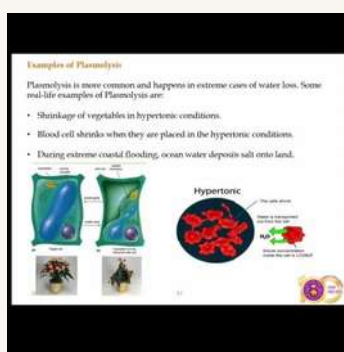
# ONLINE WORKSHOPS

Students of Grade IX visited the school's Science Park to understand the concept of propagation of sound.

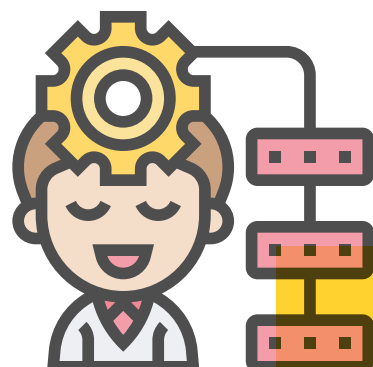
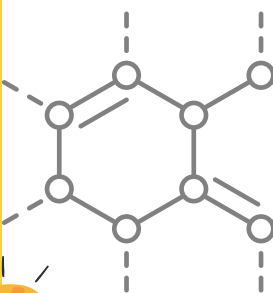

Students of Grade V visited science park and understood the concept of Measuring angles with protractor.

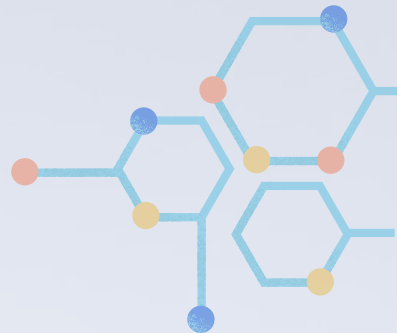
